Alice in Gatorland 2024 marks CPP's 46th Major Production! We are proud that we have been able to serve the youth of the Coachella Valley for nearly 29 years and want to continue to do so for years and years to come. Well over 140,000 children have been entertained and educated from the audience through our main stage productions, touring shows, and on-campus programs. As well, nearly 1,100 youth have participated directly in our programs and experienced the personal growth, enhanced self-confidence, and simple joy that come from this form of creative expression. The children of our communities need this type of program and deserve to continue to know that "all things are possible" can and should be the reality that they experience. CPP is the only theater-based education program in the Coachella Valley that puts local youth on the McCallum stage to perform for local youth. Peers seeing peers "create a new world" is a major factor impacting the development and growth of participants and audience alike.

WHERE WE'RE GOING!?

WE WANT TO DO MORE! There is an incredible pool of talented, creative young people in this valley who hunger to perform and simply don't have the opportunity on a regular basis.
